

THE TEACHING PHILOSOPHY

Mark Diley has been a certified PGA professional golf instructor since 1978. He is dedicated to the traditions of golf and to the highest standards of instruction.

Mark's teaching style is based on five simple principles.

- The golf swing is not a mystery. It is a teachable skill.
- An instructor's obligation is not simply to 'have' knowledge, but to impart it in easily understood concepts that the student can translate into action.
- Every student's body and swings are unique and so is their learning style. The golf coach's job is to adapt his techniques and pace to these differences.
- In the golf swing, the devil is in the details. The effective instructor must know how to carefully observe and analyze the swing to identify the areas in need of attention and to correct them.
- A relationship must form between coach and student that encourages open communication. Only when the student feels at ease with the instructor will there be the kind of learning that can be of enduring value.

HOW MARK IMPROVES YOUR GAME

Mark is widely known for his communication skills and patient manner with his students. He has worked with all levels of players, from beginner to pro, adding something to each student's understanding. In each lesson, Mark systematically assesses and corrects the swing motion using several techniques:

- **Observing** the student in detail—swing after swing—over the entire lesson.
- **Demonstrating** proper mechanics, using his own, highly refined swing motion as an example.
- **Explaining** key swing principles through the use of easy-to-understand analogies and simple illustrations.
- **Digital Video** capture of the student's swing followed by computer assisted playback analysis.
